**The example below uses a 300-mile buffer around cities with**

**populations above 10 million. The buffers closer to the equator appear smaller than the buffers further north because the Web Mercator projection used to display web maps distorts the size of objects relative to the object's distance from the equator.**

**Scanned maps and historical data usually do not contain spatial reference information. In these cases where photogrammetry cannot be used, georeferencing tools are used to align the imagery to a map coordinate system. When you georeference imagery, you define the image location using map coordinates, allowing the imagery to be viewed, queried, and analyzed with other geographic data.**

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
